- Central Division MidAm Automatics and Central Division Regional Selections
- Out of Division and Foreign entries per USSA & FIS rules
- Entered through Division or Foreign Federation by January 26, 2012

ENTRY FEES & DEADLINE

- **\$35 per day US DOLLARS ONLY Athletes not pre-paying via online registration (SEE BELOW) must pay by check or cash at registration; credit cards will not be accepted. On-Line Registration Strongly Preferred – avoid the lines!**
- Checks payable to Duluth Superior Alpine Club (DSAC)
- Divisional or Foreign Federation staff must submit all entries one week before the first team captains meeting
- Central Division MidAm automatic registrations and monies due January 26, 2012
- Central Division Regional Selection registrations deadline January 28, 2012
